

How to get to the Bella Vista

- 1. Arrived in Maso Corto: pass the barrier gate on the end of the parking area. Follow the road for about 200 meters, and you'll see our luggage lift on the right-hand side
- 2. Change into winter clothing suitable for the high mountains and deposit your luggage on the left side, under the sign that says "Arival". The luggage lift runs between 10:00 am and 4:00 pm.
- 3. Drive back outside the gate and park in the public lot
- 4. Purchase a ticket at the base station of the Senales Glacier Cable Car. If you are traveling on foot, the "Glacier Experience Card" is a good option (includes ascent and descent on the Senales Glacier Cable Car, the Grawand and the Gletschersee chair lifts for € 40,00 per person)
- 5. Take the Senales Glacier Cable Car to the top station, which is called Grawand6. Walking to the Refuge: From Grawand take the chair-lift "Grawand Sessellift Nr. 2" downhill, than take the chairlift "Gletschersee Sessellift" downhill, from there walk about 10 min. to the "Talstation Hintereislift". From there walk up to the Mountain Refuge (walk on the right side of the slope for about 20 min.). If you prefer we'd be happy to pick you up by snowmobile at the base station of the Hintereis chairlift. (€ 10, per couple, before noon or after 3:00 p.m.)

IMPORTANT:

For pedestrians: Please keep in mind that you will be entering wintry, high-alpine terrain and temperatures up here can easily reach -20 °C. Put on high winter boots or warm, waterproof hiking shoes, long thermal underwear, ski pants, a warm jacket, scarf, hat and thick gloves. Of course sun/ski goggles and sunscreen with a high SPF are also a must.

For skiers: Although the last cable car departs from Maso Corto at 4:15 pm., skiers should be sure that they depart no later than 3:30 pm. If you depart too late, the Hintereislift, which you have to take in order to get to therefuge, will have already closed
